ORDER

1. The appellant, being aggrieved by non furnishing of complete information, has filed under Section 19 (3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 second appeal against Respondent No. 1, Public Information Officer (PIO) and Respondent No. 2, First Appellate Authority (FAA), which came before the Commission on 05/10/2023.
2. Notice was issued to the concerned parties, pursuant to which, appellant appeared in person and requested for complete information. Smt. Anusha Gaonkar, PIO appeared and undertook to furnish the information.
3. During the hearing on 05/01/2024, Smt. Fatima Figueiredo, APIO appeared on behalf of PIO and filed reply stating that, she has furnished the information through the Talathi of Goltim Navelim. Appellant, who is present in person, acknowledged receipt of the information and with his signature on the appeal memo, requested permission to withdraw the present appeal.

4. Upon perusal, it is seen that, the information sought by the appellant has been furnished to him. Since the appellant has requested permission to withdraw the appeal, the Commission sees no reason for further intervention in the matter.
5. Hence, the instant appeal is disposed as withdrawn and the proceeding stands closed.
